TODAY'S READINGS -

Isaiah 11:1-10, Romans 15:4-9, Matthew 3:1-12

SCRIPTURE REFLECTION

In today's Gospel reading, we see John the Baptist baptising huge numbers of people "from Jerusalem, all Judaea and the whole Jordan district." And while he was sceptical when Pharisees and Sadducees approached him for baptism, he foretold them that "the one who follows me (Jesus Christ) is more powerful than I am and that his baptism will be with the Holy Spirit and fire."

This episode reminds us of the power for good that has been given to us through the sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation. They seal our Christian identity and give us a close bond to Jesus himself (made even stronger, of course through the Sacrament of the Eucharist), who is always willing to help us to live by his Word and be positive in our lives as Christians.

Are we ready to take up that challenge?
