FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT (A) 26 March 2023

Dear Parishioners

Next Sunday is Palm Sunday, the 9:15am and the 11:30am Mass begins at the school hall, please make sure that you arrive on time. The Vigil Mass at 6:00pm begins with the Palm Sunday Liturgy at the back of the Church. Please do try to arrive early.

With the celebration of Palm Sunday, the solemnity of this sacred time, Holy Week begins, we will be having morning, evening and night prayers, during the week, let us follow through on that experience in the Holy Week ceremonies of Holy Thursday night, Good Friday afternoon and the great Easter Vigil of Saturday night.

This Sunday, we celebrate the third and last of the Scrutinies. We pray that Tabitha and all the elect may be given the faith to acknowledge Christ as the resurrection and the life and that they may be filled with the hope of the life-giving Spirit as they prepare themselves for their birth to new life, we will also present the Lord's Prayer to the Elect—and "wait in joyful hope" until she can pray it with us as one of the faithful at the Easter Vigil.

TODAY'S READINGS - Ezekiel 37:12-14, Romans 8:8-11, John 11:1-45

SCRIPTURE REFLECTION

In today's Gospel we hear that Jesus receives a message from Martha and Mary saying 'Lord the man, you love is ill.' Jesus was indeed a great friend of this family, yet when he heard that Lazarus was ill he delays and says "This sickness will not end in death but through it the Son of God will be glorified." When he reaches them Lazarus has been in the tomb for 4 days.

Whilst this narrative contains a theological teaching (a prelude to the resurrection of Jesus), we see the very human side of Jesus. It is a story of human grief that brings sadness and heartache to all who mourn. Jesus weeps for the death of his friend, Lazarus and is moved with pity at the sorrow of his two sisters. He asks for the stone to be rolled away at the burial site and calls in a loud voice "Lazarus, come out." Lazarus appears still enshrouded; Jesus calls to those around to "unbind him - let him go free."

Do we, in life, hear when the Lord calls 'Come'? Can we let go of the ties that bind us? Blessed are they who mourn.

RCIA/JOURNEY IN FAITH

On the 3rd, 4th, and 5th, Sundays of Lent we will be having a Scrutiny for Tabitha, now one of the elect, who is preparing for the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist supported by her Godparent Sudha.

This weekend the Scrutiny will be celebrated at the Sunday 9.30am Mass.

The Scrutinies are a vital part of the process of the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults known as the RCIA and occur during the period of Lent. They are Rites of self-searching and repentance and have above all a spiritual purpose. The Scrutinies are meant to heal all that is weak, defective, or sinful in the hearts of the elect; to bring out, then strengthen all that is upright, strong and good.

The Scrutinies are celebrated to protect the elect against temptation and to give them strength in Christ who is the Way the Truth and the Life. These Rites, therefore, should complete the conversion of the elect and deepen their resolve to hold fast to Christ and carry out their decision to love God above all.

TAKING THE HOLY SACRAMENT OF COMMUNION TO THE SICK AND HOUSEBOUND

On the first Sunday of every month (after 9.30 Mass) Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist visit those in our parish who are unable, through health or disability issues, to attend Mass but wish to receive the Sacrament of Holy Communion.

The Ministers take Holy Communion to them and offer it with a short service that can be built around the capacity of the person being visited. This can be done for someone who may be recovering from an injury and/or an operation or indeed someone who has a long-term condition.
