TODAY'S READINGS -

Genesis 2:7-9, 3:1-7, Romans 5:12-19, Matthew 4:1-11

SCRIPTURE REFLECTION -

As we start Lent we see Jesus alone in the desert, a place without distraction, with nowhere to hide and nowhere to shelter. The desert isn't a place of escape but of utter honesty, a place of learning and formation.

In the starkness of the desert Jesus is tempted to dishonestly avoid the reality of human suffering with quick fixes (turning stones into bread). He is tempted to treat the love of his Father as an owned privilege rather than a pure gift (by throwing himself from the temple and being miraculously saved). And he is tempted to be served rather than to serve (worshipped by the kingdoms of the world). The characteristics of Jesus' mission – empathy with the suffering, loving service to all and a deep relationship with the will of his Father – are forged during these 40 days in the desert.

This Lent, Jesus asks us to face ourselves with truthfulness. To try and find a little quiet time when we can go to a "desert" - a place in our hearts where it is just God and me. And to spend time praying honestly about our lives. To listen and learn about what God want us to do and who he wants us to be.

POPE FRANCIS' MESSAGE FOR LENT 2023

"In addition to the Scriptures, the Lord speaks to us through our brothers and sisters, especially in the faces and the stories of those who are in need." In preparation for Lent 2023, Pope Francis has released his annual message, which this year reflects on the story of Jesus' Transfiguration.

The Holy Father encourages us to listen to what Jesus wants to tell us through the Scriptures and through others, reminding us our Lenten path is a synodal journey. He writes: "Like the ascent of Jesus and the disciples to Mount Tabor, we can say that our Lenten journey is 'synodal', since we make it together along the same path, as disciples of the one Master."
