This weekend we are introducing a small business card size blue card that says "St William of York Forest Hill, Weekly offertory Collection" with a QR code.

This card serves two purposes

- 1. Parishioners who give through weekly/monthly Standing Order can collect it from the narthex at the beginning of Mass and simply drop the card when the collection basket passes by.
- 2. Every parishioner, including those who contribute through a standing order can collect the card and using the QR code (given that you have the QR code scanner downloaded on your smart phone) can use it for the first or second collection.

We believe this will further facilitate and make your giving easier and help the process of making a planned giving possible.

TODAY'S READINGS -

Zephaniah 2:3,3:12-13, 1 Corinthians 1:26-31, Matthew 5:1-12

SCRIPTURE REFLECTION -

In the sermon on the mount, Jesus calls for a transformation of our hearts. He begins with the beatitudes, blessing those who seek to do God's Will with humble sincerity. He promises comfort to those who mourn and salvation to those who endure persecution for the sake of righteousness, especially when it is for his name's sake. He goes on to warn against the principles of the Pharisees, who calculate ways to follow the letter of the law without caring about the spirit of love underlying it. He is fulfilling Ezekiel's prophesy, that God will remove our hearts of stone and give us hearts of flesh. He wants us to care. He wants us to love God, who first of all loved us, and to care for the people around us as much as we care about ourselves. Later, Jesus tells us that all the Law and the prophets are contained within those two commandments. PB
