TODAY'S READINGS - Acts 2:1-11, 1 Corinthians 12.3-7, 12-13, John 20:19-23

SCRIPTURE REFLECTION -

Today's Scripture readings illustrate the beginning of our Church in a joyful and dramatic fashion. John's Gospel relates the moment when the risen Jesus appears in the room where the disciples were hiding and calls down the Holy Spirit on each of them before sending them on their mission in his name.

The outcome of this meeting and the episode related in Acts, where "tongues of fire" rested on the disciples and the Holy Spirit gifted them with the ability to speak in any of the languages which were being spoken by the many nationalities in Jerusalem for Pentecost, show the difference which the Holy Spirit can bring to people's lives.

Our lives may not be as dramatic as that of the Apostles, but the Gift of the Holy Spirit which we received at our Confirmation enables us to do God's work, whatever challenges life may throw at us. We only have to ask.

PROPOSED CHANGE TO THURSDAY MORNING MASS FROM JULY 2023


