TODAY'S READINGS - Isaiah 40:1-5,9-11, 2 Peter 3:8-14, Mark 1:1-8

SCRIPTURE REFLECTION - Our Gospel encourages us to prepare a way to let Jesus into our lives. The rich imagery in this Sunday's readings highlight many wonderful aspects of our Lord and God. A God who loves us as we are, who consoles us, forgives us and seeks us out, giving us time to change. A shepherd who holds us close and wants no one to be lost. This advent we are encouraged to invite God's love in and to see other people through Jesus' loving eyes. Having baptised people with water, John the Baptist explains that the baptism Jesus brings, immerses us in God's Spirit of love.

Our war-torn, unjust world is crying out for us to show love and to recognise when we need forgiveness. Our advent preparations might include listening more when we encounter different opinions. Preparing a way might mean looking for good intentions when we feel tempted to judge.

If we are losing sight of God and others, our challenge is to create a little space for reconnecting with the glorious generosity of our God. MMcD
