TODAY'S READINGS -

Genesis 12:1-4, 2 Timothy 1:8-10, Matthew 17;1-9

SCRIPTURE REFLECTION -

It must have been an incredible experience for Peter, James and John. Here they were, as they must have been on several other occasions, accompanying Jesus to an isolated place to pray. On this occasion, however, the Gospel tells us that they witnessed something totally unexpected, both wonderful and frightening at the same time. There was Jesus, brilliantly bright and glowing, holding a conversation with two familiar figures from their nation's history – Moses, Israel's leader through escape from Egypt and many years of journeying towards the Promised Land, and Elijah the Prophet. Finally, most scary of all, the voice of the Lord God from the cloud, affirming who Jesus was – the beloved Son of God.

We know, in spite of this wonderful encounter with the Father, Peter was to deny ever knowing Jesus, Judas was to betray him, while the rest of the Apostles, with the exception of John were to flee for their lives, leaving only John, of the three visionaries, staying with him until he died on the cross. They were human, just like us: would we have behaved differently?

In the cynical and material age in which we live, we may have to face direct challenges to our faith. Thinking of the transfigured Christ may help us to treasure and strengthen it and have the courage to hold firm if we are challenged - by colleagues at work, for example. Are we ready for the challenge?
