#### SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT (B) 25 FEBRUARY 2024

**THIS SUNDAY'S READINGS** - Genesis 22:1-2,9-13,15-18, Romans 8:31-34, Mark 9:2-10

**THIS SUNDAY'S SCRIPTURE REFLECTION** - When we climb a mountain, the houses below gradually get smaller and the detail of our lives can no longer be seen. It gives us perspective.

Jesus saw the value of taking time out to pray and wanted Peter, James and John to have that experience too. The vision of Jesus talking to the great prophets, Moses and Elijah, puts their new faith story in context. Today we could thank God for the people who first inspired our faith journey.

Jesus took three disciples, so they could have a shared experience. Being a Christian is a community journey. So we could also thank God for the people who are currently walking with us and inspiring us. Who offers us a steadying hand when the path is steep or rocky? Who encourages us to catch our breath and enthusiastically points out the view?

Our special spiritual moments may not be as dramatic as the transfiguration, but they strengthen our faith. Feeling a deep peace, or unconditional love or forgiveness, or

being moved by something beautiful helps us feel fully alive and connected. It can be even more wonderful if we invite others to come and see something that we don't find easy to put into words.

This lent we're invited to spend time with God's beloved son, Jesus, and to listen to his word, and recognise him in others.

God gave the disciples a glimpse that Jesus would conquer death, that God's love transcends death. We cannot fully understand. We are sometimes in the cloud. But we come back down the mountain enriched when we journey together.


