TODAY'S READINGS -

Genesis 18:20-32, Colossians 2:12-14, Luke 11:1-13

SCRIPTURE REFLECTION

A favourite theme of Luke in his Gospel is Jesus at prayer. Luke describes Jesus at prayer after His baptism in the Jordan by John, (Luke 3:21), at His Transfiguration, (Luke 9:29), and for a whole night in the Galilean hills before choosing the twelve apostles. (Luke 6:12). In today's Gospel, Luke again has Jesus at prayer "in a certain place" as He journeys with them to accomplish the consummation of His mission in Jerusalem. (Luke 9:51). In reply to a disciple's request to teach them how to pray, Jesus gives them, and us, what we know as "The Lord's Prayer".

We are more accustomed to Matthew's version, (Matt.6:10-13), with its seven petitions, which Luke has pared back to five. Both numbers have spiritual significance in Hebrew thought. Jesus follows up by stressing to His disciples with a parable the need for persistence in prayer, and gives His own assurance - "So I say to you" - that by praying with untiring constancy in asking, searching and knocking, they, and we, will receive from our heavenly Father the One essential Good necessary for growth and fidelity in our faith lives - the Holy Spirit.
