Dear Parishioners

Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of the Season of Lent. It is a special time of prayer, penance, reflection, sacrifice and good works in preparation of the celebration of Easter, through which we attain redemption. As we mark ourselves with Ashes as a sign of Penance we also commit to prayer, fasting, and almsgiving.

We usually think of and try to "give up something" for Lent. The sacrifices in Lent are really penance, in the same spirit as the Ninevites that repented at the preaching of Jonah. Throughout our history, Christians have found prayer, fasting, and almsgiving to be an important part of repentance and renewal.

Let us all try to add something during Lent rather than focusing only on giving up something, either to address personal habits that need work or to add some outreach to others in need. if you feel that you have the desire to become deeper connected to your faith and your church, consider if you may have a talent you can offer for our parish. Our music ministry is always welcoming new people that wish to participate in the Mass through a joyful signing to the Lord. You can consider joining any of the parish ministries and groups according to your talents and interest.

Take advantage of the Bible reflection on Tuesday evenings at 8:00pm, followed by refreshments in the lower hall, and Benediction and Stations of the Cross on Fridays at 10:00am after the morning Mass.
