## TODAY'S READINGS - Acts 8:5-8, 14-17, 1 Peter 3:15-18, John 14:15-21

### **SCRIPTURE REFLECTION**

Like the people in the early church, we ask ourselves how to relate our faith to our lives. In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus reassures us that we are not alone. That God's Spirit is not just with us, but in us.

We can know the Old Testament commandments and the teachings of Jesus to love ourselves and others. But it is a wonderful gift to have God's Spirit guiding us towards the spirit of the law and the authenticity of Gospel values.

Sometimes we're faced with situations where we aren't sure what to do or say. If we listen, God's Spirit can help us work out what the most loving approach might be, and encourage us to have faith and to trust our instincts for good.

Today's Gospel reassures us that we are loved. It invites us to be conscious of God's Spirit within us, supporting us to grow in love of God and each other.


