THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT (A) GAUDETE SUNDAY 11 DECEMBER 2022

John the Baptist sends his disciples to our Lord to find out whether Jesus is the Messiah. We know from another text of Matthew's gospel that John recognises Jesus, he may have done that to help his disciples know who Jesus was. In this time of Advent, we pray that we recognise that Jesus is coming for us.

If during this Advent, we struggle in accepting that he is coming for us, may this Joyful Sunday and its message increase our hope of the coming Jesus, may he come into our lives help us to rediscover gratitude for all that we are, for all that we have and do, many in our world live without this expectation, without hope. When we do take this time of advent, time of penance and conversion, we become God's children who free themselves and experience joy.

TODAY'S READINGS -

Isaiah 35:1-6,10, James 5:7-10, Matthew 11:2-11

SCRIPTURE REFLECTION

From his prison cell, John the Baptist sends a message to Jesus asking whether He is indeed the Messiah – it seems that he has been expecting dramatically powerful divine intervention in the style of the Old Testament. Jesus answers with confirmation that the words of the prophet Isaiah are being fulfilled, that the blind see, the deaf hear, the lame walk, lepers are cleansed, the dead are raised to life, and the Good News is proclaimed to the poor. Isaiah's prophesy goes on to describe the Messiah as the obedient servant of God, taking on himself the suffering caused by our transgressions. Jesus describes John as the prophet sent to prepare people for the coming of the Messiah, but even John is not as great as the least in the kingdom of heaven. We all, including John the Baptist, need the saving power of Jesus' death and resurrection to free us from slavery to sin, allowing us to enter the kingdom of heaven.
