# THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT (B) 17 December 2023 Gaudete Sunday

#### **Dear Parishioners**

On the third Sunday of Advent, we celebrate Gaudete Sunday, we are invited to be witnesses of joy for two reasons: first, because God our Father sent his beloved Son Jesus Christ who "is the light of the world" The second reason for our joy is, through Jesus' mission, God has poured out the Holy Spirit in each of us and inviting us to be a church, an outgoing and open to all.

This Sunday's Word of God invites us to be this bright sign of joy, despite wars, injustices, ecological disasters, which leave us worried and without much hope of an authentic change in the world situation and of an effective conversion of ourselves and others.

We pray that the imminent feast of our Lords birth, may bring us true and lasting peace to our world and to all affected by the lack of it. May it also experience God's peace through the healing we receive in this time of conversion.

God Bless Fr Habte TODAY'S READINGS - Isaiah 61:1-2,10-11, 1 Thessalonians 5:16.24, John 1:6-8, 19-28

SCRIPTURE REFLECTION - In today's Gospel John the Baptist is questioned about who he is. Who is this man, drawing crowds in the desert? Is he the Christ? John explains he is not, he is a forerunner and a witness. He tells them that the one they seek stands unrecognised amongst them.

This Gospel reading poses the two challenges which are at the heart of Advent: Firstly, like John the Baptist, we are challenged to humbly point to Christ. As individuals and as a community of faith we are called to lives of love and service, witnessing to our God. This is how we point to Jesus and direct the hearts of all we know to meet our God of love.

Secondly John's words challenge us, as much as his questioners, to discern the presence of God, standing unrecognised in the midst of us. We are challenged to recognise our God in the features, minds and hearts of the poorest and the unpopular, the unassuming and quiet, those who we find hardest to love and even recognise Him in our own hearts. God is with us, Emmanuel, but the chances are that we won't recognise Him unless we stay alert.

Our mission as Christians is to point to a God who is in the midst of His people, but who is incognito. To fulfil this vocation we need to embrace the self-effacing humility of John the Baptist and have faith in the wonderful and mysterious presence of God in our world.
