

TODAY'S READINGS - Proverbs 31:10-13,19-20,30-31, 1 Thessalonians 5:1-6, Matthew 25:14-30

SCRIPTURE REFLECTION - The three servants in Jesus' parable are each given a small portion of their master's property and trusted to improve on it. In the same way that the master gave his servants responsibility for his money, so God has given each one of us gifts that we have not earned and He expects us to build on them. We have different abilities and opportunities in life delivered by many variables, such as where we were born, the nature of our family, our education and the people we meet. These gifts are distributed unevenly, as were the talents given to the servants, but more will be required of those who are given more, and even those given little will be expected to do something with it. We may feel that we have little to offer, but if we bring ourselves to do what we can with what we've got, guided by the light of Christ, then, as when he fed the five thousand with a few loaves and fishes, he will turn our small effort into something much larger. Like the good servants sharing the joy of their master, we will discover the joy of using God's gifts for His good purposes and He will increase our ability to share His love with everyone we meet.
