TODAY'S READINGS- Isaiah 25:6-10, Philippians 4:12-14,19-20,

Matthew 22:1-14

SCRIPTURE REFLECTION -

The guests who were invited to the wedding feast made lots of excuses for not attending. If we have a living faith we should put God and our faith at the centre of our lives. This may sometimes involve making choices about whether to attend church or go to another activity or whether to take part in an activity which is contrary to what our faith stands for and may involve an element of sacrifice. There has been a decline in church attendance in recent years especially since the pandemic. For families it may be that their children are interested in an activity which takes place on a Sunday or is contrary to Faith values so a choice has to be made about whether our Faith has the importance it deserves.

When the original guests didn't accept the wedding invitation, the host invited those on the margins of society who accepted the invitation straight away. Often people living in difficult circumstances show great compassion and acceptance to others which isn't always reciprocated. We should be welcoming towards everyone whatever their circumstances without discrimination.
