Dear Parishioners

'Each one should give as much as he has decided on his own initiative, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver' – 2 Corinthians 9:7

TODAY'S READINGS- Isaiah 5:1-7, Philippians 4:6-9, Matthew 21:33-43

SCRIPTURE REFLECTION - The chief priests and elders are questioning Jesus' authority, but they dare not arrest him for fear of the people, who hold him to be a prophet. Like Isaiah, in the first reading, Jesus uses the analogy of a vine to illustrate the waywardness of God's chosen people. The kingdom of God is compared to a vineyard which is occupied by tenants, who are the people chosen to protect and share the Truth revealed by God. When the servants of God and, ultimately, the Son of God come to collect the produce of the vineyard, they are rejected, beaten and killed. The chief priests and elders are condemned out of their own mouths when they say that the faithless tenants should be replaced by other tenants, who will deliver the produce in due season. Jesus reveals that the kingdom of God will indeed be given to a people who will produce its fruit. We are that people who have been given the kingdom of God. We receive it freely and we should share it freely, nurturing God's vineyard by caring for those around us; loving God, who first of all loved us, and loving our neighbour as ourselves.
